Public Rights Under Title VI

Family Bridges, Inc., as a Federal Transit Administration (FTA) fund recipient ensures that both of our Hong Fook Adult Day Health Care and Hong Fook – Harisson Street Centers are in compliance with the Department of Transportation (DOT) Title VI Regulations of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

Under the Title VI Program, Family Bridges assures that our Hong Fook Centers' participants receive quality transportation services, which provides that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity that receives Federal financial assistance.

If you believe that as a participant, you have been subject to any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI, then you may file a complaint with Family Bridges, Inc.
